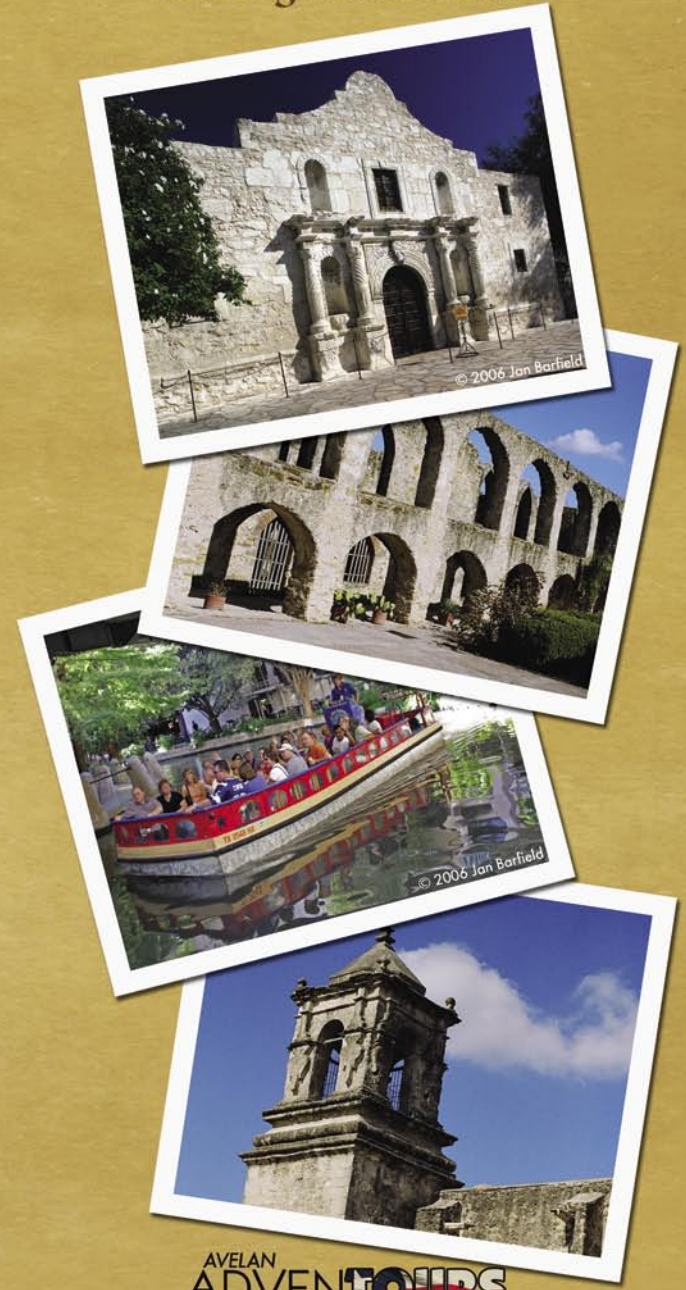

Alamo, Mission San Jose, Mission Concepción, King William District, San Fernando Cathedral, Market Square.

**Alamo** - The cradle of Texas Liberty, where 189 brave men fought for freedom from Mexican General Santa Ana in 1836.

**Mission San José** - The Queen of the Missions, founded along the San Antonio River in 1720.

**Mission Concepción** - The oldest, unrestored stone Catholic Church in the United States, where numerous frescos from the 1700's remain.

**King William District** - An elite German neighborhood that dates back to the 1870's. See the streets lined with beautiful Victorian mansions.

**San Fernando Cathedral** - Completed in 1750, San Fernando is known as the oldest Cathedral sanctuary in the United States.

**Market Square** - The largest Mexican market in the United States, where History is tied to the color of the present.

**Fredericksburg/Hill Country** - Head for the hills surrounding San Antonio and visit the charming town built by the early German pioneers. This settlement was established in 1860. Enjoy shopping for crafts, antiques, and savor the authentic German cuisine. Visit the Lyndon B. Johnson Ranch just a few miles away.

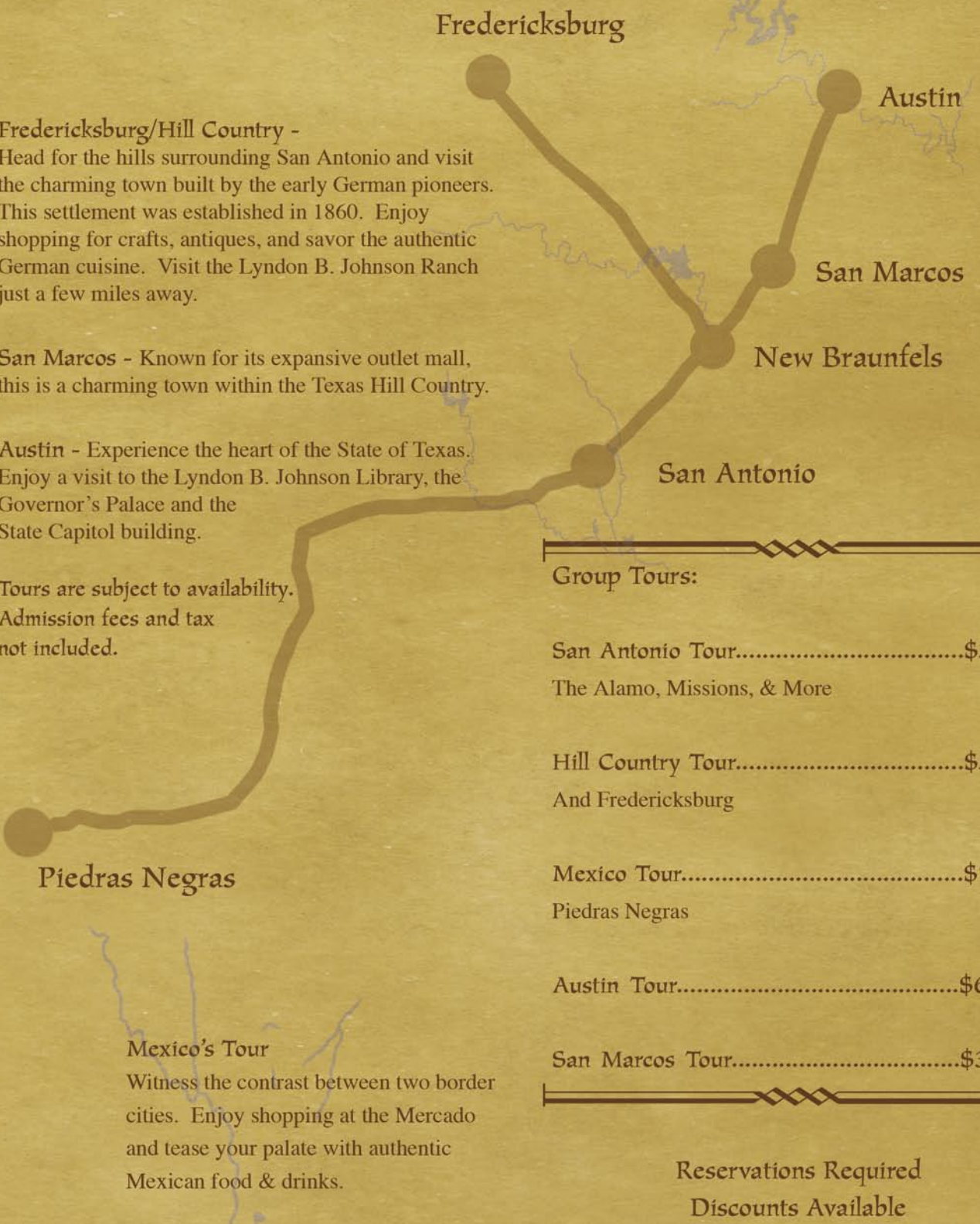
**San Marcos** - Known for its expansive outlet mall, this is a charming town within the Texas Hill Country.
